From the Desk of Town Supervisor (Pat Flynn):

- Application for Water District 1 (the Northeast area of the Town) submitted to the NYS Controller's Office for approval
- Filed State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) as lead agency for Water District 1 stating there is non-significant environmental impact for Water District
- Town of Torrey continues to work with the Village of Dresden in finalizing a water agreement for Perry Point Water District

 Identification of lost dogs and provides protection for the

community. It is also NYS Ag & Market law- **ALL** dogs harbored in the Town of Torrey must be licensed yearly at the Town Clerk office).

From the Desk of Town Highway Superintendent (Tim Chambers):

- Off hours emergency callout number: 315-729-2706
- With Town Board approval the Highway Department replaced a 1992 Gradall with a 2009 Excavator model M316C purchased from the Town of Milo
- Using Community Highway Improvement Projects (CHIPs)
 funds several roads throughout the Town were paved or stoned and oiled
- Torrey Cleanup Days were held July 28th and 29th with 6 dumpsters being filled as well as 1 metal only dumpster
- Reminder according to NYS law:
 - + throwing trash, garbage, rubbish, litter or refuse on Highways and adjacent lands is <u>prohibited</u>
 - + the town superintendent of highways shall sue for and recover a penalty not to exceed \$100 from any person depositing ashes, snow, ice, stones, sticks, etc. upon a highway or on grass or loose stones adjoining a town highway

- Year-to-Date there have been 78 permits issued and \$6661.60 permit fees collected

- Developed regulations on Solar Energy and submitted to the Town
 Board for approval at the September 11th Town Board meeting
- Has begun investigating the options for dog kennel/breeding regulations
- Investigating a possible need to revise the zoning regulations dealing with mobile homes/manufactured housing

In November of 2014, the Town of Torrey passed a local Wastewater Law effective January 1, 2015. Under the new law, any onsite wastewater treatment system within 200' of Seneca Lake or a DEC classified stream is required to be inspected every 5 years. The cost of the inspection is borne by the Town of Torrey (unless this is a property transfer). However any pumping of the septic or repair is a cost to the homeowner. We are now in year 4 of these inspections.

From the Desk of the Mayor of Dresden (Bill Hall):

- Village tennis courts have been repaired and relined
- Village of Dresden and Village of Penn Yan have reached an agreement on an amended Authorized Water District Territory
- Town of Torrey and Village of Penn Yan are finalizing an agreement regarding Water District 2 (Perry Point)

- There is a dire need for volunteer firemen in Dresden. All residents of the Town of Torrey are welcome.

- Town of Torrey Summer Recreation has concluded. The program ran from July 2nd through August 10th with an average of 10 -12 children each day
- Seneca Lake Pure Waters Association (SLPWA) stream sampling in the Keuka Outlet began April 23rd. Sampling is done every 6 weeks throughout the Summer. Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs) monitoring started July 28th and will continue through Columbus Day weekend. Check their website
